GENERAL REPORT

Community Advisory Board (CAB) members surveyed 40 individuals at the SUNY Sullivan Annual Holiday Craft Fair on Sunday, November 18, 2018. Folks received a short questionnaire with the following questions: Are you listening [to WJFF]? If no, why not? How do you listen? Where do you listen? When do you listen? Anything else you want to tell us? Zip code?

Responses reflected that **most** of the sample said they do listen to WJFF. For those who marked that they **do not** listen, most marked "poor reception" as their reason.

Most respondents indicated that they listen on their radio, in their car or home; very few said they listen via the app.

Most respondents said they listen to the radio during their morning or evening travel time.

Survey respondents marked their zip codes for Liberty, Loch Sheldrake, Woodbourne, Hurleyville, Rock Hill, all the way out to Accord. *Full results on following two pages*.
