DCOC Meeting

August 11, 2022

The first meeting of the DCOC opened with casual conversation and introductions.

Pat Pomeroy made a motion that Halle Kho be nominated for the chair, Amy Brightfield seconded the motion. All were in favor.

Halle requested nominees for the secretary position. Pat volunteered to be the interim Secretary.

An agenda and supporting documents had been distributed by Halle...the committee decided to focus on the Community awards event which is schedule for either 10/13 or 10/20 at Piccolo Paese.
