BOT Meeting and Agenda

Angela Page has resigned from the BOT and her position at the CAB liaison is being filled by Leila McCullough. We'll ask her if she's willing to continue as the liaison going forward.

Kirsten will make presentation about committee goals for 2022. The Nom & Gov committee is tasked with a By Laws review, which is also available from NYCON.

Liberty Station

Collier Construction has submitted their Gross Max Price (GMP) quote and itemized estimates totaling \$973K. The ZETA broadcast software is not included with a remaining balance due of \$15K.

Discussion was held regarding the Jeff Bank Construction loan, reinforcing the Finance committee recommendation to increase the loan from \$225K to \$400K.

There are no plans or estimates for Solar energy installation. This was a big part of the promotional effort when the station move to Liberty was first announced four years ago. The station was created based on hydro-power as a renewable energy source, the

commitment to renewable energy has been a strong part of the station identity. We can subscribe to solar energy without having to physically install it on the property.
